In providing consent for your child to take part in SWCC group rides and activities you are confirming to SWCC that your child has the following experience, knowledge, appropriate equipment and behaviors.

- Their bike is well maintained, and they possess and carry the required roadside mechanical tools allowing them to perform basic repairs such as punctures
- They will follow the Ride leads (or deputy's) directions at all times

- Riders are strongly advised to have 3rd party liability insurance (through organisations such as British cycling or Cycling UK).
- The Highway Code rules for cycling will be strictly observed throughout all club rides and your child must understand his / her responsibilities in accordance with the rules for cyclists within the Highway Code:

- Any arrangements for collecting / meeting your child at the end of the ride should be agreed with the ride leader before departure. This may include allowing your child to cycle home from the end point of the ride.

Parental / Guardian Consent

I, being the parent / guardian of the child identified above, have read all the information on this form and associated links and give consent for my child to take part in events and club rides organised by SWCC.

I understand and agree that the child identified participates under the guidance of an experienced ride leader entirely at his / her own risk. I have considered the nature of such rides and have discussed them with my child. I am satisfied that they are sufficiently responsible and competent to assume full responsibility for their own safety under the supervision of a ride leader.

In the event of my child being unable to complete the ride (due to a mechanical issue which cannot be resolved) I consent that my child may be left alone once contact has been made with yourselves to arrange recovery or homeward transport (e.g. taxi).

I consent to emergency first aid being administered to my child in the event of an accident and emergency services being called (if required) prior to me/us being notified.
